S – Scriptures

“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.” Psalm 139: 23

C – Consideration

David in this amazing Psalm revealed the Omnipotence, Omniscience and Omnipresence of God Almighty as he starts to declare the wonders of God in creation and the glory of God in his wonderful wisdom and power. By the end of his writings, he becomes angry against God’s enemies, and in the last two verses he plea with the Lord to search his heart and see if there is any offensive way or sinful behaviours hidden in the deepest of his soul. He also points out that his anxieties could lead him away from the truth, he had mentioned in the former verses and concludes: “and lead me in the way everlasting.

C – Commitment
