S – Scriptures

"They are not just idle words for you—they are your life. By them you will live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to possess." Deuteronomy 32: 47

C – Consideration

"When Moses finished reciting all these words to all Israel, he said to them, "Take to heart all the words I have solemnly declared to you this day, so that you may command your children to obey carefully all the words of this law." In chapter thirty, God had challenged Israel, "This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses.
